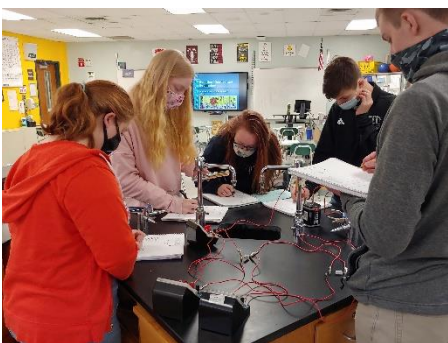
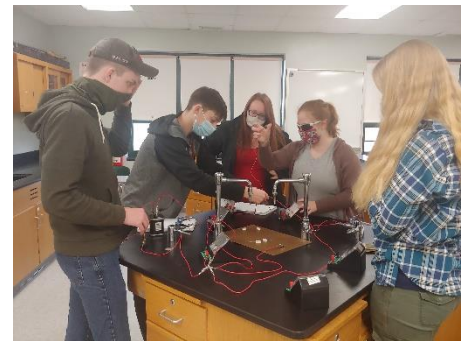
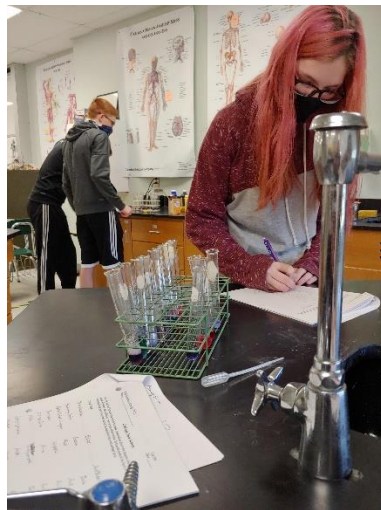
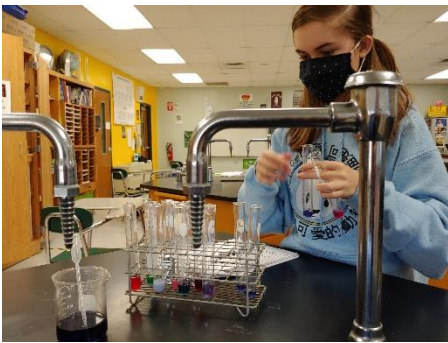
Mr. Levine explained to the eighth grade how to apply what they've learned from building and testing their bridges to real world situations.
