

# January 2021 Board Report

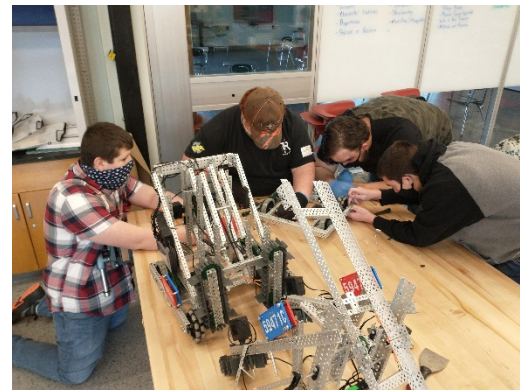
