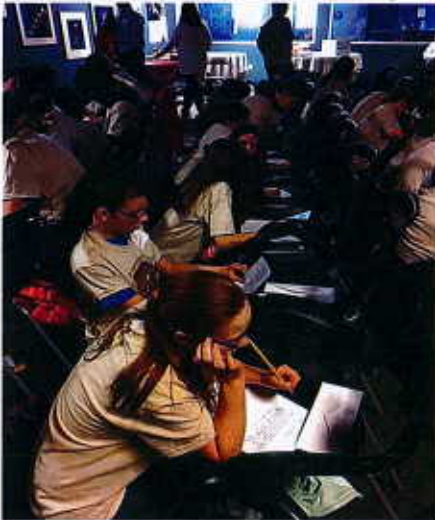


## February Board Report

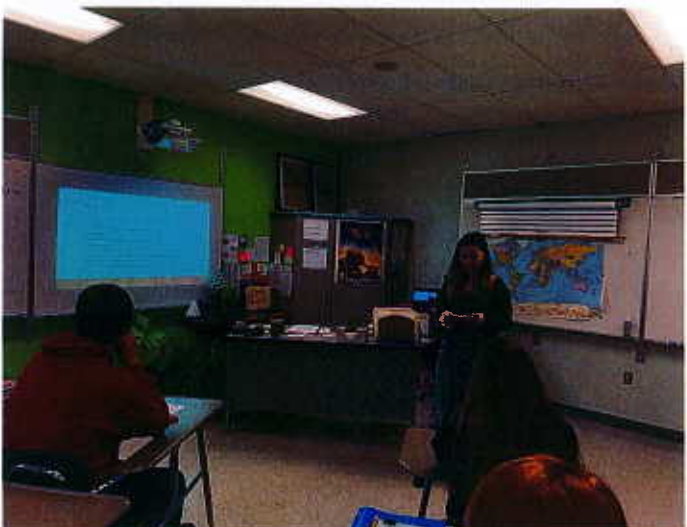
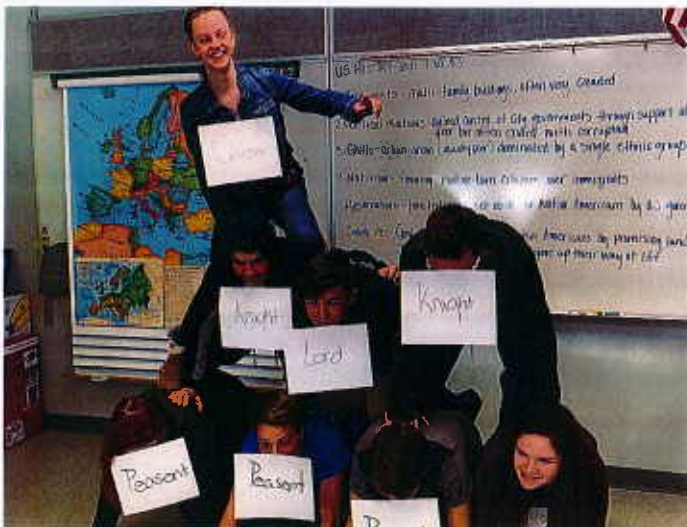
