Fun in the Jungle Summer Camp Rules

- Students will not be permitted to leave the GV campus during the day unsupervised for any reason and under any circumstances.
- Students may not attend camp if they are ill with a fever, cough, body aches or pains, diarrhea, sore throat, loss of taste or smell or any contagious illness. Students must be picked up immediately in the event of illness at camp.
- Appropriate attire must be worn at all times. Students are expected to swim every day and should pack a swimsuit, a towel and a plastic bag for wet clothing. Please have your child wear sneakers and outdoor
- recreational clothing and apply sunscreens or bug repellent before coming to camp. Please label all of your child's belongings.
- Remember this is camp, so please leave at home ANYTHING you would not want to lose or damage.
- Students must leave all cell phones in their backpacks and i-Pods, i-Pads or other electronic devices at home.

We ask that all parents/guardians go over this Code of Conduct with their children. We place high importance on all students treating others in a positive, respectful way.

Student Code of Conduct

- We will be respectful, honest and kind. Use positive language, be gracious competitors, show good sports etiquette and share.
- Be considerate to others and the environment by cleaning up after yourselves.
- In a group situation, please no talking while someone else is speaking, always raise your hand if you have something to contribute and use inside voices indoors.
- Follow the teacher's directions, if you do not understand, ask questions!!
- No violence, throwing things, pushing, rough housing, profanity or demeaning language.
- Be especially careful in the pool, no horseplay in the water.
- Always ask a teacher to settle an issue between students. Don't take matters into your own hands.

If a camper doesn't follow the Code of Conduct, we follow a progressive discipline philosophy and will always bring in the parent early in the process.

Consequences of Not Following Code

- The camp Director will determine disciplinary action after teachers report incidents and consequences may include: 1) Gentle reminder 2) 15 minutes aside from group activity 3) Call parent/guardian and leave for the day 4) Student will be suspended from attending camp.
- Fun in the Jungle Summer Camp reserves the right to immediately dismiss any student from the program for extremely disruptive behavior, for behavior placing a student/staff's safety in jeopardy or any violence.
 Examples include but are not limited to: 1) Intentionally hurting another student 2) Stealing 3) Refusing to comply with a safety directive 4) Violence, etc.
